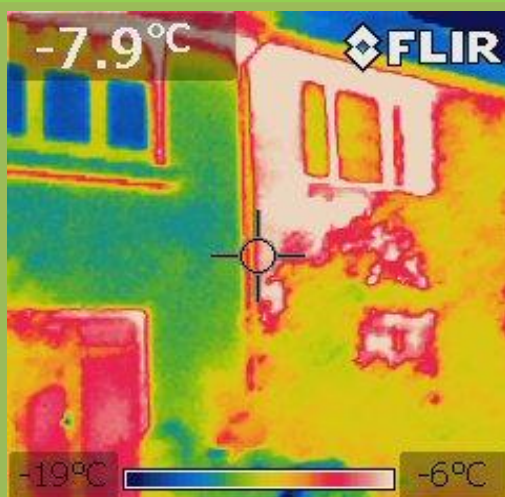
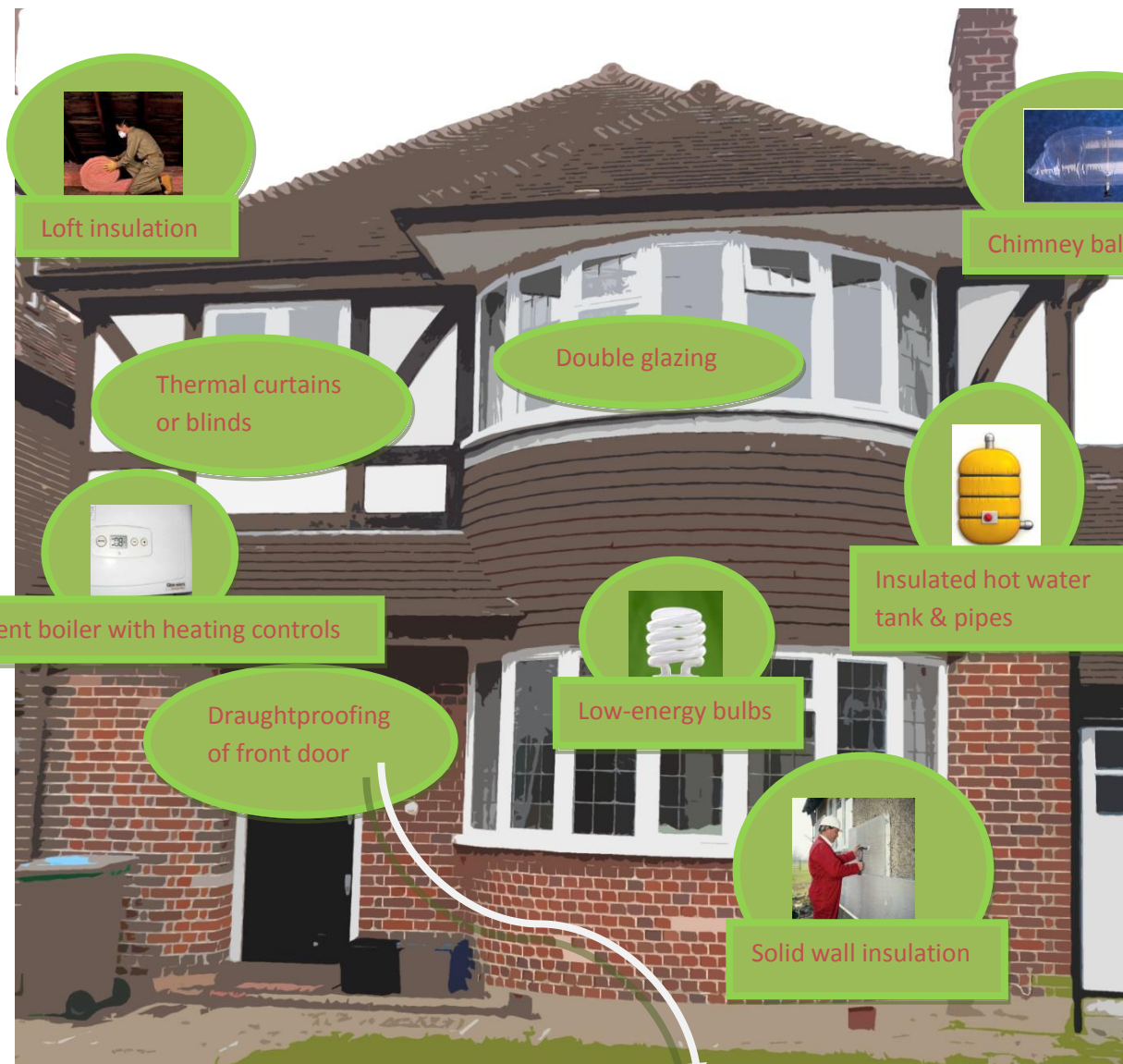


Ham & Petersham Street Champions' Guide to improving your home's energy efficiency

What are the grants on offer? What schemes will be available in the future? Why should I retrofit my home?

- Installing energy-saving measures like loft insulation in your home can save money and cut your carbon emissions. It can make your home feel snuggier and warmer through cutting out draughts and keeping the heat inside.
- In October 2012, the government will be introducing a new scheme to help homeowners install these measures at low cost – it's called the Green Deal and involves giving you a loan which you use for installing energy-saving measures such as loft or solid wall insulation. Then you repay the loan from the resulting savings you make on your energy bills. Expect to hear more about this scheme as October approaches.
- The Warm Front scheme provides heating and insulation improvements to households on certain income-related benefits living in properties that are poorly insulated and/or do not have a working central heating system. Qualifying households can get improvements worth up to £3,500. The Warm Front scheme is currently undersubscribed, and £30 million-worth of grants could go unclaimed. The deadline for applicants is 31 March.
- The Government's Energy Efficiency Commitment (EEC) has been replaced by the Carbon Emission Reduction Target (CERT). This means energy suppliers with a certain number of customers operating in Great Britain are obliged to achieve targets for improving home energy efficiency. All the major suppliers are currently providing a range of offers which significantly reduce the cost of installing energy efficiency measures.
- The Energy Saving Trust website <http://www.energysavingtrust.org.uk> is a mine of useful information on everything to do with saving energy. You can also phone their helpline on 0800 512 012.
- Three providers offer an Energy Trust scheme for their account holders in hardship, to help cover energy arrears and sometimes other essential household items. Essential items are covered by Further Assistance Payments and can include white goods, boiler repairs or funeral costs. Those who live in a home supplied by the provider, but are not account holders, can apply for the Further Assistance Payments only.
- For other providers or general advice, Homeheat is a not for profit phone line that gives advice on grants (both for energy arrears and insulation), benefits, reduced tariffs, special payment options and energy saving tips to people struggling to pay their bills and keep warm.
